Ability to undertake majority of course as self-paced

Sufficiently proficient in English (read, write and speak)

Previous qualification to AQF Level 4 or above

Ability to work in a highly regulated environment

Ability to demonstrate vocational competency in the proposed industry.

Digital Literacy to the extent of undertaking training and assessment online

21 years of age or above

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

What if I cannot complete my course in 8 months?

In case you fail to complete your TAE course in 8 months, you can re-apply for the incomplete units at a nominal fee and continue until completion.

Can I withdraw from the course after enrolment?

After enrolling for a course, you get a 5 day cooling off period to decide if you wish to continue with the classes and units. If you withdraw in this period, you get a full refund minus \$250 payable towards the administrative costs.

A student is not eligible for any refund in case of withdrawal if:

- He/She has enrolled for a short course
- He/She withdraws during the course delivery period

Am I eligible to become a trainer and assessor immediately after completing Certificate IV Training and Assessment?

In order to become a trainer and assessor after completing the course, you must meet the industry currency and compliance for the industry you have chosen. This depends upon your experience in the industry, volunteer work in the field and qualifications which need to meet the level that you wish to train and assess. This can be gained by:

- Working part time in the industry
- Taking up accredited training for the industry
- Engaging with the industry
- Being part of industry associations
- Reading material related to the industry
- Staying current with technology and trends in the industry

What if I miss my scheduled classes?

Recorded classes are available for students to make up for missed classes. Our supportive faculty will also help you cope with any difficulties that you have with units as a result of missed classes.

How can I transfer credits from other vocational competencies?

You can transfer course credits for any previously attained, equivalent units within your current enrolment. You can also transfer credits if the training packages that you have completed earlier supersede or are equivalent to the current units as per the Training Package Guidelines.
