Re: Application for change of scope of registration

I refer to your application to change the scope of your organisation's registration.

In accordance with the provisions of the [National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011 \(NVR Act\)](#), your application has been granted under delegation of the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (the Regulator).

The National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (the Regulator) is the person appointed to make decisions under the NVR Act, and works as a part of the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA). ASQA's work supports the Regulator in their decision-making. The Regulator may delegate their decision-making power to another person at ASQA. When this occurs, it is referred to as a decision made under delegation.

- ICTCBL323 *Test cables and systems on customer premises*

You are required to comply with the conditions of registration set out in Sections 22-28 of the Act, as well as any additional conditions that the Regulator imposed on your organisation's registration.

There are no additional conditions imposed on your organisation's registration as a result of approval of your application to change your scope of registration.
